Providing convenient transportation services has been the business of CRIS Rural Mass Transit District for over 30 years. Our service provides on-time dependable transportation services to the residents of Vermilion County.

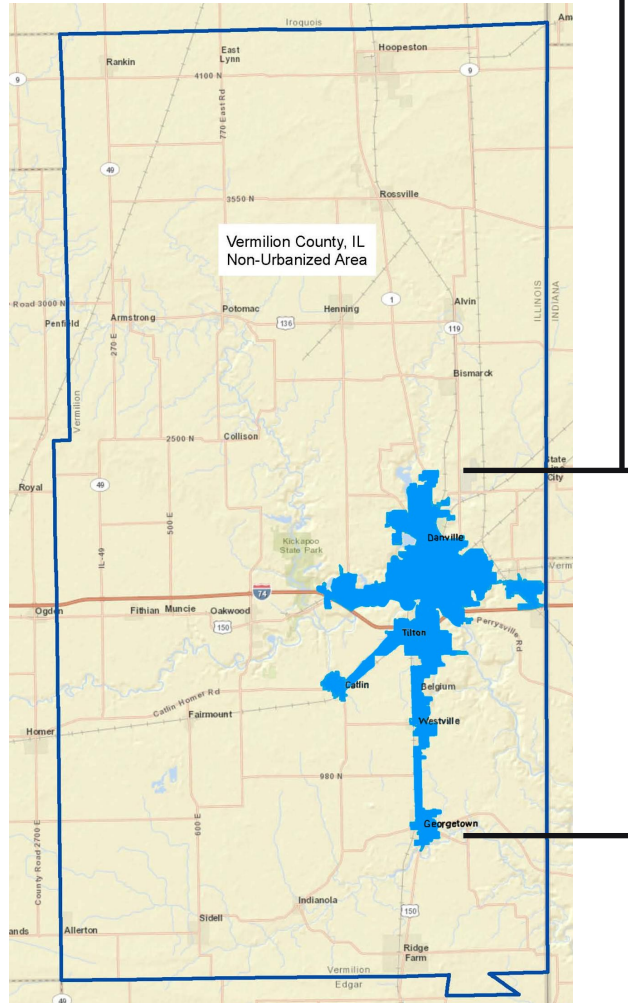


CRIS Rural Mass Transit District provides curb-to-curb* transportation services between the hours of 6:00 am and 6:00 pm, Monday through Friday and 8:00 am to 4:00 pm Saturday (except holidays).

Who is eligible? Any resident living in Vermilion County needing a ride from the rural areas of the county to the urbanized area of Danville, or visa-versa.

How to make reservations? Call Cris Rural Mass Transit District at (217) 443-2BUS (2287) at least 48 hours (two working days) in advance to schedule your ride. Multiple pick-ups can be arranged with one call. **This is a shared ride service, so please allow 15 minutes leeway in pick up and drop off.**

The Urbanized area of Vermilion County includes Danville, Tilton, Westville, Georgetown and Catlin and includes all areas within 3/4 mile of these city boundaries and the corridors in-between.



What is the cost? The fare from outside the Vermilion County Urbanized Area to within the Urbanized area of Danville-Tilton-Westville-Georgetown-Catlin (or Visa-Versa) for:

General Public, 59 & younger **\$4.00 each way**
Seniors, 60 & over **\$3.00 each way**
Disabled Clients (any age) **\$3.00 each way**

Checklist for Riders

- Call CRIS Rural Transit at least 48 hours (two working days) in advance to schedule your ride.
- A registration is required from all new clients. This information can be taken over the phone when you call to book your first ride.
- Determine if rider requires a PCA for assistance. A PCA can ride with a client for no additional cost.
- Have correct change or a check for the required fare to ride.
- Children, age 12 and under may ride when accompanied by an adult. The children's fare is \$1.00 in all zones.

*Curb-to-Curb Service: The client must be able to enter and/or exit destination without assistance from the driver. The driver will assist the client in entering and leaving the bus. If you require additional assistance, remember a Personal Care Attendant (PCA) may ride with you at no additional costs.
